Smithville Square Description and Highlights

Smithville Square is a Curexa-anchored retail center in Galloway Township, in the heart of Atlantic County, with a rare 33,500 SF anchor box now available. Positioned on Route 9 with 277 feet of frontage and signalized access, the center sits just 4 miles from Exit 44 of the Garden State Parkway and less than 20 minutes from Atlantic City. Galloway Township is home to Stockton University's main campus and its enrollment of nearly 10,000 students, anchoring steady year round demand across the trade area.

The property spans 106,931 SF across 25.88 acres with 542 parking spaces and is anchored by Curexa Pharmacy alongside an e-commerce-resistant lineup of daily-needs and service tenants. The available 33,500 SF anchor box offers exceptional visibility, deep parking, and flexible Configuration — divisible to 20,000 SF — making it ideal for a national or regional operator seeking a high-visibility Atlantic County location. With new residential development underway nearby, including a 120-unit Class A apartment complex directly across the street and a 130-bed assisted-living facility approved less than a mile away, Smithville Square is positioned to capture growing demand with aggressive deal terms for the right tenant.

STOCKTON UNIVERSITY — REGIONAL ENROLLMENT DRIVER

Stockton University's main campus sits in Galloway Township, just minutes from Smithville Square, with an enrollment of nearly 10,000 students plus faculty and staff. As one of New Jersey's largest public universities, Stockton generates consistent year-round demand for retail, dining, fitness, and service uses across the immediate trade area. The steady flow of students, families, and campus employees gives Smithville Square a built-in, recession-resistant customer base seeking convenient shopping and everyday needs close to campus.

ATLANTIC CITY — REGIONAL ENTERTAINMENT & DEVELOPMENT HUB

Located less than 20 minutes from Smithville Square, Atlantic City is one of the Northeast's premier entertainment and tourism destinations, home to the Borgata, Caesars, Harrah's, and the iconic Boardwalk. The region is in the middle of a significant wave of new investment, including the approved \$3.3 billion redevelopment of Bader Field and a 400-acre mixed-use logistics hub at Atlantic City International Airport. This influx of capital is driving economic and population growth throughout the surrounding communities, including Galloway, strengthening the long-term fundamentals of the trade area and demand for well located retail.
